KEY OUTCOMES

- scheduling: critical path analysis, gantt charts
- earned value analysis and project controls
- budgeting & cashflow
- resourcing & time, cost, quality trade-offs
- decision-making & teamwork in a project scenario

LOGISTICS



- the simulation workshop can be run with anything from 8 to 80 participants, and over a 1 to 2 day timeframe
- it can be run with teams in one classroom, or separate rooms, or in online events with remote participants
